

RULES OF THE PRIZE GAME “MAGICAL WEEKEND GETAWAY”

1. General provisions

The rules below set out the process by which the prize game is to be conducted and the terms and conditions of participation. Organizer of the prize game: In516ht d.o.o., Dunajska 22, 1000 Ljubljana. VAT nr.: SI 66861446 (hereinafter referred to as: organizer).

The prize game will be conducted in United Kingdom (London) on October 3rd. By taking part in the prize game, participants accept these general terms and conditions and confirm that they are familiar with them and that they agree to abide by them.

2. Purpose of the prize game

The purpose of the prize game “Magical Weekend Getaway” (hereinafter referred to as: prize game) is to promote In516ht’s services and solutions at The Snowflake Summit World Tour in London. Advertisement and participation shall take place in accordance with the regulations on the advertising of services represented by the contracting authority.

3. Participants

Any individual attending The Snowflake Summit World Tour in London may take part in the prize game, regardless of the place of their permanent residence. Organizers of the prize game, their immediate family members (spouse, extra-marital partner, parents, children) may not take part in the prize game. A person may only participate in the prize game in their own name. They confirm that all the personal details sent are exclusively their own personal details and that they agree with these rules.

4. Method of participation

Participation in the prize game involves leaving a business card or fulfilled printed form “Magical Weekend Getaway” at In516ht exhibition booth at the Snowflake Summit venue. Individuals may participate in the prize game only on one occasion. A participant may terminate their participation at any time. Termination may be requested directly at the organizer’s exhibition booth. By terminating their participation, a participant excludes themselves from further participation in the prize game and from all purposes for which personal and other data produced by the prize game is processed. The prize game winner will be at In516ht exhibition

booth on October 3rd at 17:30. Any use of false or double profiles, or the suspected use of such profiles, shall result in exclusion of the participant from the prize game.

5. Prize

The winner of the prize game will win a weekend package for 2 persons. Weekend package includes a London – Ljubljana flight, operated by Easyjet or Wizzair and an accommodation in the Hotel Jama (Jamska cesta 28, 6230 Postojna, Slovenia) for 2 nights in the double room and 2 Full Park Experience tickets for Postojna Cave Park.

The winner can use the prize in 6 months from the end date of the prize game (3.10.2019). The reservation can be made through telephone 00386 41 381 363 or email hello@in516ht.com. All details shall be agreed at that time. The maximum value of the prize is 1.000 EUR including VAT. In case that the weekend package would be more expensive at the desired dates, the winner must pay the amount above 1.000 including VAT on his/her own.

Prizes are non-exchangeable, nor may any cash equivalent be requested. A prizewinner may not transfer their prize to a third party.

6. Draw, awarding of prizes and notification of prizewinners

The draw shall take place on 3.10.2019 at the In516ht exhibition booth and shall be conducted by a commission approved by the organizer. The draw shall be conducted so that one and only one participant is drawn randomly from among those participating in the prize game.

A list of prizewinners shall be published within on <https://www.in516ht.com/news/win-a-magical-weekend-getaway-in-slovenia/> upon conclusion of the prize game. By taking part in the prize game, all participants expressly and irrevocably consent to the publication of their name, surname and place of residence. The results of the draw shall be final, and no appeals permitted.

7. Receipt of prize

In order to receive a prize, a participant must meet the conditions referred to in Article 3, and consent to the rules and the terms and conditions of participation in the prize game. If their name is drawn in the prize draw, they shall send the details that the organizer requires in order to send them the prize (name and surname, street name, postcode, place of residence, tax number, phone number and e-mail address) to the organizer by private message within 3 days. If a winner fails to send

the required precise and correct information on time, they shall be deemed to have refused the prize and the organizer shall be free of its obligation regarding the delivery of the prize to the winner. In this case, the prize shall not be awarded. Prizes shall be sent to the prizewinners by post, with the postal costs being met by the organizer or by email. The organizer may agree on another method of delivery with the prizewinner if delivery by post or email is not possible. The organizer assumes no liability for any lost or damaged postal consignments. A prize shall be deemed to have been delivered to a prizewinner when the organizer dispatches it to the address stated by the prizewinner. The organizer assumes no liability for its actual delivery. Should it not be possible to deliver the prize to the prizewinner or if the prize is returned to the organizer, the prizewinner shall be deemed to have refused the prize, which shall remain unawarded. The organizer reserves the right not to award a prize if:

- there are doubts regarding the authenticity of the details supplied;
- a prizewinner fails to meet the conditions for receiving a prize;
- it is established that a participant participated in the prize game contrary to the rules and the terms and conditions of the prize game;
- the prizewinner fails to supply the additional information required by the organizer for awarding of the prize within three days after the draft;
- in other cases in which the awarding of the prize is not possible or would not be lawful.

8. Exclusion of liability

The organizer shall accept no liability for:

- any consequences that participants may suffer as a result of participation in the prize game or prize draw;
- undelivered prizes;
- any consequences relating to the use of prizes.

9. Personal data protection

All personal data shall be protected in accordance with these rules, the general regulations of the organizer of the prize game relating to personal data protection, and the Personal Data Protection Act. Participants in the prize game expressly agree that the organizer of the prize game shall use the personal data provided by the participants within the context of participation in the prize game for the purposes of the prize game. By participating in the prize game, the participants also agree to allow the organizer of the prize game or its authorized representatives or subcontractors to use their personal data for the purpose of informing them of promotional campaigns, new products, prize competitions and other promotional activities, with an option to unsubscribe. The organizer may process the aforementioned data for its own purposes until the revocation of consent or for a

maximum of 5 years after the prize draw. While their personal data is being administered, participants shall have the right to view and update their personal data in the database.

10. Tax liabilities

An individual who is to receive a prize shall be a taxpayer under the Income Tax Act, with the gross value of the prize being included in the prizewinner's tax base. The awarder shall calculate and make a personal income tax prepayment in accordance with the applicable regulations on prizes whose gross value exceeds the legally prescribed value for the payment of income tax. The awarder shall calculate income tax prepayment and withhold withholding tax simultaneously with the calculation of other income in accordance with the applicable regulations. Any other tax liabilities or income tax adjustments in accordance with an annual income tax ruling shall be borne by the prizewinner.

11. Documentation

The organizer shall retain documentation relating to the prize game as follows: documentation relating to the organization and implementation of the prize game and these rules shall be kept at the organizer's premises for three (3) years; documentation relating to prizewinners (personal data notices, tax documentation) shall be kept in accordance with the applicable tax and accounting regulations. After the expiry of the above periods, the organizer shall destroy the documentation in accordance with its by-laws.

12. Access to rules of the prize game

Rules of the prize game can be accessed on the website www.in516ht.com by all participants.

13. Other provisions

The prize game organizer's decisions on all issues relating to the prize game and the rules pertaining to it shall be final and shall apply to all participants. In the event of any dispute or uncertainty, these rules shall be deemed primary in relation to any other publication, whether in printed, electronic or any other form. The authentic interpretation of these rules shall be determined exclusively by the organizer. The organizer of the prize game reserves the right to amend these rules if required for legal, technical or commercial reasons. Any dispute arising from the prize game that cannot be settled amicably shall be settled by the competent court in Ljubljana. These rules shall come into force on the day they are adopted.
